MICHELE PAZZOLA'S CURRICULUM VITAE

I graduated *cum laude* in Veterinary Medicine in 1999 at the University of Sassari, Italy. I am a veterinary surgeon since 2000. In 2003, I graduated *cum laude* as Specialist in Animal health, production and farming at the University of Sassari, Italy.

I worked as a veterinarian in the Italian Army (2000-2001) and in the field of beef cattle farming (2003-2005). In 2008, I was the chief of the executive council of Veterinarians' College of the Province of Oristano (Italy).

Since 2005, I have worked as a lecturer (*Ricercatore*, Assistant professor; Scientific sector of the Italian University System SSD AGR/19, Animal farming) at the Department of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Sassari. From 2005 to 2018, I was a member of the committee of the PhD School in Veterinary Science. Since June 2018, I have been a member of the committee of the Specialist School in Animal health, production and farming. I have taught the subjects "Husbandry of companion animals", "Farming of large animals", "Animal hygiene and environmental impact", "Animal Farming" and "Animal welfare". I obtained the national scientific qualification by the Italian Ministry for University (sector 07/G1, Animal science and technology) for Associate professor, in 2017, and for Full professor, in 2018.

I was the executive researcher of the projects "Lactodynamographic milk traits of the Sarda sheep" (Feb. 2012-Aug. 2013, funded by Bank of Sardinia Foundation) and "Validation of the Beta Star Combo test on sheep milk" (Apr. 2012-Mar. 2013, funded by Chr. Hansen Italia S.p.A.) and "Exploring the genomic variability at candidate genes of the Sarda sheep and the association with milk phenotypic parameters" (Dec. 2018-Dec. 2020, funded by Bank of Sardinia Foundation).

In September 2018, I attended a 10-days training period at the Animal and Plant Health Agency (APHA) Veterinary Investigation Centre, Thirsk, North Yorkshire, UK.

In March-April 2019, I attended a 7-days teaching period at the Ecole Nationale Vétérinaire de Toulouse (ENVT), Toulouse, France; and a 7-days training period at Clinique Vétérinaire d'Amikuze Behasque Lapiste, France.

I am the author of more than 100 publications in the category of veterinary and animal science, among which 67 documents are published in peer-reviewed scientific journals indexed by Scopus (<https://www.scopus.com/authid/detail.uri?authorId=23482513800>). I served as reviewer and editor for scientific journals.

I am an Italian native speaker. I speak English (B2 level) and Deutsch (A1 niveau).
